

Tuition Rates During COVID-Related Closures

The following amended tuition policy is intended to keep Nonotuck Community School financially stable so that we can continue to function and be a provider for your children throughout the COVID-19 pandemic and beyond. Thank you for your continued support and investment in our school!

In the event the state's Department of Public Health deems it necessary to temporarily close a classroom or the entire school during the 2020-2021 school year, the following tuition schedule will apply.

Length of Closure	Tuition
Up to 2 consecutive weeks	Full tuition
3-4 consecutive weeks	$\frac{2}{3}$ tuition
5-12 consecutive weeks	$\frac{1}{3}$ tuition
After 12 consecutive weeks	$\frac{1}{5}$ tuition

To parents with more than one child at Nonotuck: If one of your children's classrooms closes for health reasons, any sibling in a different classroom must also stay home during the closure.

Failure to pay tuition in accordance with this policy will result in the loss of your deposit and may result in Nonotuck not being able to hold your child's space at the school.
